

*Oscoda High School
Athletic Hall of Fame Charter*



PURPOSE:

The Oscoda Athletic Hall of Fame has been established to recognize the efforts and achievements of the past students, athletes, coaches, administrators, and contributors to Oscoda High School Athletics while reinforcing the department's rich history, pride and tradition.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

The Hall of Fame recognizes outstanding and exceptional athletic achievement. Nominees must have made a significant and distinguishing contribution to Oscoda High School Athletics. Nominees must have distinguished themselves with a high degree of character throughout their high school and post high school years.

A Hall of Fame nominee must be a high school graduate who attended Oscoda High School 10 years prior to induction. Oscoda High School teams to be considered after 10 years. No timetable for coaches, administrators or community members.

SELECTION:

The selection committee is comprised of a maximum of 9 and a minimum of 5 school and community members. As vacancies arise, new members will be appointed by the existing committee under the direction of the Board of Education. The focus of the selection committee will be to assist in researching, nominating and inducting deserving nominees to the Hall of Fame.

Members of the Hall of Fame Committee shall keep ALL committee action confidential and shall support the decisions of the committee at-large.

First year inductees will be charter members.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCESS:

Nomination forms will be available on the district website and the athletic director's office.

Nomination forms may be completed by any interested individual and directed to the office of the athletic director.

Nominations essentially come from one of four different categories: 1. Alumni student/athletes 2. Former Coaches / Administrators 3. Teams 4. Special contributors.

The selection committee may contact the nominees to request additional information.

A minimum of 6 inductees will be honored the first year. Numbers of inductees may vary each succeeding year.

Nominations not selected for induction will be kept on file for future years, pending additional achievements or new nominations.

The committee will meet and select nominees every year beginning in 2017.

Deadline for nominations will be May 1, 2017 for the initial year and April 1 each succeeding year thereafter.

RECOGNITION OF HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES:

The recognition and presentation of membership into the Oscoda High School Hall of Fame will be done at a designated ceremony. The selection committee will be responsible for planning and conducting the induction ceremony and reception.

Each inductee will receive a commemorative token of recognition.

A permanent display listing all Hall of Fame Inductees will be established in the Spirit Hall of Oscoda High School.

The purpose of the Athletic Hall of Fame is to honor the accomplishments of past students, athletes, coaches, administrators and special contributors and serve as a positive example of what is achievable for current and future Owls.

AMENDMENT PROCEDURE:

This charter may be amended by two-thirds vote of the Selection Committee.
