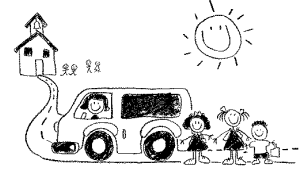

Transportation Safety Tips

When waiting for the school bus

- ▶ Stay a safe distance from the roadway
- ▶ Wait in a straight line
- ▶ No pushing or horseplay
- ▶ Walk to the bus only after the door is open



When Crossing in front of the school bus

- ▶ Stop at the edge of the bus
- ▶ Look right and left
- ▶ Look at the driver for a signal to cross
- ▶ Keep watching for traffic as you walk

Overhead Red and Yellow Lights

When overhead **yellow** lights are flashing,
 Prepare to stop.



When overhead **red** lights are flashing,
 Stop no closer than 20 feet from the bus.

Food Service Information

Breakfast is free for ALL Oscoda students. Students in grades K-6 will enjoy FREE lunch through the State's Community Eligibility Option (CEO). Please fill out the household survey form if you have

a student in grades K-6. Lunches for students in grades 7-12 are \$1.90. OHS students may be eligible for free or reduced lunch. We encourage all families with students attending grades 7 through 12 to fill out the free and reduced meal application. The application for free and reduced meals for the 2013-2014 school year and the household survey will be available during open house.

Young Owls Preschool Programs

OAS will offer a tuition-based preschool program for three & four year old children who do not qualify for the Head Start Programs or the Michigan School Readiness Program. Children must be three years of age on or before November 1, 2013 to qualify for our preschool program. The program will begin September 24, 2013 and will be held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. A morning session will be held from 8:15-10:45 a.m. and an afternoon session from 12:00-2:30 p.m. Registration is \$135 for a nine-week session, which amounts to only \$5 per class. Payment plans are available, if necessary.
