General Terms and Conditions

The Oscoda High School is offering a **One-to-One Computing Program** that can provide a real-time, real-world, relevant education. Furthermore this can increase thinking and problem-solving skills and information communication technology skills meeting community needs and student's expectations. It is the mission of OHS to provide the best possible education to all students, and to afford them access to technology needed to meet their learning needs. OHS is committed to preparing students for success in a changing world. To prepare our students for success, OHS believes that students need to have access to dependable technology in order to enhance the learning experience.

This agreement enables those students who do not have access to a computer at home to complete their school work at home.

The student is expected to follow the same policies with the laptop that are enforced in school. Under no circumstances will the students use the laptop or permit the laptop be used in furtherance of any crime; fraud; threat, defamation; plagiarism; copyright, patent, or trademark infringement; illegal or legal downloading; viewing pornographic or violent images; bullying or harassment (including cyber-bullying) or any unlawful activities of any kind.

Loss, Theft, or Damage

Students will be expected to inspect their laptop for physical damage with the staff member before checking it out and upon returning it the next day. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that their laptop is taken care of at home and used solely for school related work. If damage is done to the laptop there will be a fee that you/your student is responsible for.
